Frequently asked questions

How do we find out about events and skating dates?

We send out emails, so please make sure that we have your email address. Phone calls are made only in case of emergency. You will receive a copy of the roster via email with contact information of all skaters and parents. We also have a website that has all the forms and the calendar posted on it, www.everettsilverblades.com . Calendars and information will not be printed this year. Please check the website regularly for additional updates.

How often do I check my email?

During the season you should check it at least twice a week. The best days would be Monday and Friday. Please don't use "Reply to All" when replying to email.

Fundraiser, do we have to do them?

We have fundraisers to benefit the team and the individual skater. We strongly recommend that you do the fundraisers. If you have an idea for a fundraiser please let me know. We want to keep everyone's costs down!

When and where do we make our payments?

Payment are made monthly, we also can do a bimonthly payment if that works better for you. There is a file box that has a file for payments, a receipt will be in the file that has your skaters name on it. Be on time with payments.

How do I know what I need for hair and make-up for competition?

We will let you know what colors of eye shadow, lip stick you need. You always need black mascara, base and blush. For you hair you need hair ties, several hair nets, gel, "Got 2 Be Glued" hair glue, small spray water bottle, comb and brush. We usually do the hair as a group, we will show you what to do. We don't use bobby pins or hair clips at competitions and exhibitions. Hair must be worn up during practice at all times (bangs included and can be pulled back with clippies – NO Bobbie Pins).

Practice, Competitions & Exhibitions

Remember that the skaters are on TEAM time. Even though we travel individually, skaters and parents are expected to follow team rules. Airplane tickets, hotel etc you pay for. Hotel rooms are booked as a group.

Be on time. Be prepared. Participate. ALWAYS Good sportsmanship.
